APPLICATIONS ARE INVITED FOR IAVP ANNUAL AWARDS-2020

The Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists has instituted a number of awards. Awards are distributed to Veterinary Pathologists who have excelled in professional competence as assessed by appropriate criteria. The IAVP administers several categories of awards. Where an application is required, the last date for receiving award application is approximately one month before the opening day of conference. The awards are listed below with respective criteria for each one of them. **Only Members of IAVP are eligible for the awards**. Non-members, if otherwise found eligible for any award, the President may consider them for special awards. Applications of following awards are invited:

YOUNG SCIENTISTS AWARDS (Three Nos.)

IAVP considers young pathologists as its future of profession and encourages them by rewarding and awarding by a number of awards and honours. There are three awards for young scientists presenting scientific papers during annual conference/ webinar. Three best presentations in a specially organized session are considered for the award. The awards are the following:

- 1. IAVP-Dr Balwant Singh Memorial Young Scientist Award for Best Oral Presentation
- 2. IAVP-Dr S.K. Nigam Memorial Young Scientist Award for Second Best Oral Presentation
- 3. IAVP-Prof. S. Ramachandran Memorial Best Molecular Oncologist Presentation Rules of the Award (1 & 2):
- 1. The scientific papers may be on any topic with a bearing on Veterinary Pathology.
- 2. The work in question must have been carried out exclusively in any institution in India.
- 3. The person who is presenting the papers should be one of the authors and not have completed 35 years of age and must have made major contribution to the work (A certificate from the Head of the Department / Institution with age proof is to be sent along with the paper).
- 4. The presentation should be completed in 8-10 minutes with 2 more minutes for discussion, depending upon the availability of time.
- 5. The President, IAVP shall constitute a 'three members committee' to select the Awardees and the decision of the judges will be final.
- 6. The papers adjudged for awards would be published in Indian Journal of Veterinary Pathology. Hence, a copy of the full paper along with photographs, tables, etc. should be submitted to the Chief Editor after the Conference.
- 7. The participants for this award should submit abstract to the Organizing Secretary before the last date of conference as per announcement, indicating the paper to be presented for Young Scientist Award. Last minute intimation to shift a paper from any technical session to Young Scientist Award will not be entertained.
- 8. This Award contains certificate to all authors.

Rules of the Award (3):

- 1. The first recipient of the award should be a Life Member (s) of IAVP below 35 years age.
- 2. The award is given to an individual or to a team of scientists, which need to best at the time of application.
- 3. The presentation should be completed in 8-10 minutes with 2 more minutes for discussion, depending upon the availability of time.

- 4. The research work should be original contribution to Molecular Oncology carried out during the past three years in any of the Veterinary Institutions in India.
- 5. The President, IAVP shall constitute a 'three members committee' to select the Awardees and the decision of the committee shall be final.
- 6. The participants for this award should submit abstract to the Organizing Secretary before the last date as per announcement, indicating the paper to be presented for Young Scientist Award. Last minute intimation to shift a paper from any technical session to Young Scientist Award will not be entertained.
- 7. This Award contains certificate to all authors.

POSTER PRESENTATION AWARDS (3 Nos.)

There are **three awards** for the Best Poster Presentations of poster papers during annual conference. The awards are:

- 1. IAVP-Best Poster Presentation Award
- 2. IAVP-Organizing Secretary Second Best-Poster Presentation Award
- 3. IAVP-Savithree Jibachch Sinha Third Best-Poster Presentation Award

Rules of the Award:

- 1. Full scientific papers along with the abstract (250 words) may be submitted to the **Secretary General, IAVP** before the closing date.
- 2. One PPT format of poster per presenter will be accepted for presentation having original contribution and work must have been carried out in India.
- 3. The PPT format poster should have Introduction, Material and Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- 4. The President of the IAVP shall constitute a **'three members committee'** to select the Awardees and the decision of the committee shall be final.
- 5. This Award contains certificate to all authors.

JOURNAL AWARDS

There are four awards for the articles/papers published in the Indian Journal of Veterinary Pathology. Four awards are given every year. During current year awards will be judged for completed issues of the journal published in previous year, 2019.

- 1. IAVP-Dr C.M. Singh Award for Best Full Research Article (Non-Pack Animals)
- 2. IAVP-Dr S. Damodaran Award for Best Oncology Paper/Case Report
- 3. IAVP Dr B.S. Rajya Award for Best Non-Oncology Short/ Rapid Communication
- 4. IAVP-Gang-Mana Sharma Award for Best Article/ Case Report on Pack Animals NB: Award Evaluation Process is in progress separately.

BEST POST GRADUATE THESIS AWARD

There are four awards for the Best MVSc/PhD Thesis Award. These are as follows:

- 1. IAVP-Prof. P.K.R. Iyer Memorial Best MVSc Thesis Award
- 2. IAVP-Dr Ram Raksha-Kiran Shukla Award for Second Best MVSc Thesis
- 3. IAVP-Best PhD Thesis Award
- 4. IAVP-Dr P. Rama Rao Memorial Second Best PhD Thesis Award

Rules of the Award

- 1. The Thesis should have been approved (including viva-voce examination during January to December of preceding year-2019).
- 2. The research work must have been exclusively conducted in India.
- 3. Thesis should accompany a certificate from the major advisor that it was completed during the stipulated period of time as per the institution/ University norms-to be submitted at the Conference.
- 4. Applicant should submit PDF of thesis and other documents by e-mail to the **Secretary General IAVP** by the closing date for processing.

- 5. The President of the IAVP shall constitute a **'three members committee'** to select the Awardees and the decision of the committee shall be final.
- 6. This Award contains certificate for student and supervisor.

IAVP-ACHIEVEMNT AWARDS IN SPECIALITY SUBJECTS

IAVP has instituted six achievement awards in speciality subjects to encourage and honour middle aged Veterinary Pathologists. Details of awards is as follows:

- 1. IAVP-Best Farm Animals Pathologist Award (Annual Award)
- 2. IAVP-Best Poultry Pathologist Award (Annual Award)
- 3. IAVP-Dr B.L. Purohit Memorial Best Toxicologist Pathologist Award (Annual Award)
- 4. IAVP-Best Companion Animal Pathologist Award (Biannual Award- Even Year viz. 2020, 22, 24 etc.)
- 5. IAVP-Laboratory Animal Pathologist Award (Biannual Award-Even Year viz. 2020, 22, 24 etc.)

Rules of the Award

- 1. Outstanding contribution in the field of specialization as evidenced by publications and track record of peer recognition.
- 2. Periodicity of Award is mentioned against each award.
- 3. The minimum of 10 years experience is essential for specialty award.
- 4. Submission of last three years outstanding research contribution of the individual/team would be the major criteria although track record of previous contributions would also be considered.
- 5. Scientist/ Faculty once awarded is not eligible for same award.
- 6. Send application with a summary of work done report along with PDF of full report for evaluation before closing date to **Secretary General IAVP**.
- 7. Please indicate the specialty to which you would like your award to be considered and include a cover letter stating how your publications and recent contributions are relevant to the topic.
- 8. This Annual Award contains a certificate.

IAVP- Special Encouragement Awards

1. IAVP-Best Veterinary Pathology Teacher Award (Annual Award)

IAVP instituted this Award in 2018 for encouraging best teachers in discipline Veterinary Pathology.

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Outstanding contribution in the field of UG/ PG teaching, guiding and students research publications and track record of peer recognition.
- 2. The minimum of 15-year experience is essential for this specialty encouragement award
- 3. Submission of last three years outstanding teaching contribution of the individual would be the major criteria although track record of previous contributions would also be considered in the absence of competition among recent performers.
- 4. Teacher once awarded is not eligible for this award.
- 5. Send application in PDF with a summary of your achievement report before closing date to the **Secretary General IAVP**.
- 6. This Annual Award contains a certificate.

FELLOWSHIP OF INDIAN ASSOCIATION OF VETERINARY PATHOLOGISTS

Rules of the Award

- 1. Outstanding Pathologists based on their contribution to the advancement of Veterinary Pathology or Veterinary Education /Research/Association building activity can apply for the Fellowship.
- 2. The applicant should be a Veterinary Pathologist of eminence at least 45 years of age and had contributed significantly in advancement of Veterinary Pathology for 25 year with a standing of 10 years as Life Member.
- 3. The PDF of the application along with publications with NAAS-ratings, impact factor, citation indices or other widely known indices of scientific performances includes self-Appraisal Report of 250 words which may form part of the citation, if selected for the award.
- 4. Full biodata including with all contributions in Veterinary Pathology.
- 5. Forward your nominations through zonal secretaries or two supporting letters from eminent pathologists in favour of the candidate (normally Fellows) to the **Secretary General IAVP** along with a demand draft for Rs 1,000/-favouring the Treasurer, IAVP payable at Bareilly.
- 6. This Annual Award contains a citation and certificate.

- 7. Last date for receipt of Award application is 10-12-2020.
