Dr. Ratan Chandra Ghosh was born on 16 Feb, 1962 at Maniknagar, Kolkata. He completed his BVSC & AH in 1986 frm Vidhan Chandra Krishi Vishwvidyalay, Mohanpur, WB, MVSc in 1989 Birsa Agriculture University, Ranchi, Bihar and PhD in 1999 from University of Surrey, UK with Commonwealth Scholarship. Having briefly worked as Veterinary Surgeon in Animal Husbandry Department of West Bengal, he joined as Assistant Professor in the Deptt of Veterinary Pathology, College of Vet Sci, Anjora, Durg in July 1989, became Associate Professor in May, 2000 and finally rose to the post of Professor of Vet Pathology in August, 2013. He has been

serving as Head of the Department since September, 2004.

Dr. Ghosh is engaged in U.G., P.G and Ph. D teaching of Veterinary Pathology and research and extension activities for the last 23 years. He had a brilliant academic career having secured first division right from the Secondary examination to M.V.Sc. He had been a recipient of ICAR fellowship during B.V.Sc. & A.H. Dr Ghosh was a topper in the final B.V.Sc. & A.H. examination and was awarded with Vice Chancellor's Gold Medal and Certificate of Merit. He was awarded with the Commonwealth Scholarship during 1995 for PhD, which he completed with distinction from the University of Surrey, Guildford, U.K in the year 1999. He has also visited USA and Turkey to present his research work. He has made significant contribution on Aflatoxicosis in Poultry.

Dr. Ghosh has guided 18 M.V.Sc and 2 PhD students as major advisor and 26 students as minor advisor. Two of his M.V.Sc students have bagged Dr. B.V. Rao Poultry Research Foundation Research Grant. He has published more than 80 research papers in the International and National journals. He has contributed a chapter on 'Healing of wound' in 'A Text Book of Veterinary Pathology' by Dr. H.V.S. Chauhan. He has successfully completed two research projects as Principal Investigator. Recently, he has been awarded with the Fellow of National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India) 2010. He has also cleared Board Certification Examination of the Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists- 2011 and become Diplomate, ICVP. He has acted as Organizing Secretary for two Central Zone meetings of Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (IAVP) and National Seminars.
