CITATION FOR AWARD OF THE IAVP FELLOWSHIP-2014

Dr. D.V. Joshi was born on 1st October, 1961 in the Mehsana district Gujarat. He obtained his B.V.Sc & A.H. and M.V.Sc degrees from College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, Anand in the year 1985 and 1989, respectively. He did his Ph.D. in Veterinary Pathology in 1996 from the College of Veterinary Sciences, G.B. Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, Pantnagar. He started his career as junior lecturer in Livestock Inspector Training Centre, Sardarkrushinagar in September, 1985 and rose to Professor & Head, Department of Veterinary Pathology, College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, S.K. Nagar, Gujarat.

Dr. Joshi has rich experience of 30 years in teaching and research. He has so far published 73 research papers in national and international journals of repute. He has presented more than 110 research papers including 6 lead papers in 45 seminars/symposia and 9 training programmes /summer schools. He has been recipient of 14 awards which includes IAVP-Young Scientist Award-1996; IVJ-Dr. K.S. Nair Memorial Prize-1998; IAVP-Varsha Award-2000; IAVP-Best Poster Awards 2001, 2002 & 2011; Dr. J.P. Trivedi Award-2003; University Best Teacher Award, 2006-2007; IAVP President Appreciation Award-2009 for outstanding performance as Zonal Secretary, West Zone. His three M.V.Sc students also received Chancellor's Gold Medal for Best Post Graduate research work.

Dr. Joshi has so far guided 25 M.V.Sc and 1 Ph.D. student. Dr. Joshi has isolated canine parvovirus from the diarrheic dogs in India for the first time. He has worked mainly on canine parvo viral diarrhea, neonatal calf diarrhea, etiopathology of lamb mortality and toxicopathology of various heavy metals and newer pesticides in rats. He has established a modern diagnostic pathology laboratory and a pathology museum in his department. Dr. Joshi is life member of several scientific bodies and member of editorial board of three journals of international repute. He has acted as external examiner/paper setter/thesis evaluator of different SAU's in India.

Dr. Joshi has organized three Gujarat State Chapter IAVP Meets and one West Zone IAVP Meet. He has successfully organized five refresher courses on "Laboratory Techniques for Animal Disease Diagnosis" for the Veterinary Officers of the Govt. of Gujarat. As a Chairman of Student Representative Council, Dr. Joshi has organized a number of extracurricular activities and various sports events in SDAU. He is very popular amongst the student community.

The Association confers Fellowship and the title of Fellow of Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (FIAVP) on Dr. D.V. Joshi for his outstanding contributions to the advancement of Veterinary Pathology in India.
