CITATION FOR AWARD OF THE IAVP FELLOWSHIP, 2021

Dr Kuldip Gupta (54), an eminent Veterinary Pathologist, is Professor of Veterinary Pathology, Department of Veterinary Pathology, College of Veterinary Science, GADVASU, Ludhiana. He was born on April 20, 1968, did graduation in 1992 and MVSc (Veterinary Pathology) in 1995 from PAU, Ludhiana. He was awarded University and Brig. HL Bhandari Memorial Gold medals and certificate of Honour in UG and University Merit Certificate in PG. He joined as Assistant Professor (Veterinary Science) at Dr Yaswant Singh Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry, Nauni, Solan in 1995 and later on joined as Assistant Professor at PAU, Ludhiana in 2001. He has completed PhD in 2011 and became Associate Professor in September, 2011 and Professor in September, 2014. Dr Gupta cleared the certifying examination of ICVP in 2018 and is a Board Certified Pathologist.

He has worked extensively on infectious bursal disease, avian oncogenic viral infections in poultry and canine mammary neoplasia. Currently, working on cytopathology of cutaneous and abdominal neoplasms in dogs. He standardized One-step polymer HRPO Staining for canine mammary neoplasms and immunohistochemical technique and multiplex PCR for diagnosis of mixed avian oncogenic viral infections. Dr Gupta has Published 142 research papers in National and International journals of repute with a cumulative NAAS score of 703.47. In addition, published 6 technical/extension articles and 58 fullpapers in proceedings of conferences, seminars, trainings and workshops. He has guided 7 MVSc and 2 PhD students as major advisor, and co-guided 12 MVSc and 7 PhD students. Additionally, he acted as expert for many courses, seminars and symposia. Received a number of awards including prestigious Drs. Nemi Chand Jain and Jawahar Lal Vegad Award for Outstanding Research in Veterinary Pathology, Prof. (Dr) S. Ramachandran Memorial Molecular Oncology Award, Dr Patri Rama Rao Award for best PhD thesis and Savithree Jibachch Sinha Best Poster Award etc. Dr Gupta has been actively participating in the various activities of IAVP and ICVP. He also served as member of editorial team of Indian Journal of Veterinary Pathology in 2012-13. He has actively contributed towards preparation of ICVP Model Training Document and training of students for ICVP certification examination.

The Association confers Fellowship and title of Fellow of Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (FIAVP) on Dr Kuldip Gupta for his outstanding contributions to the advancement of Veterinary Pathology in India.
