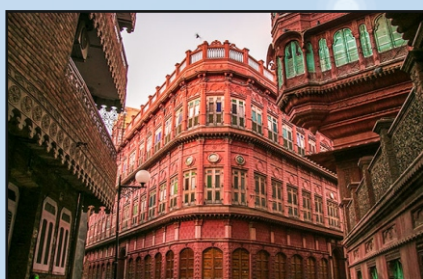
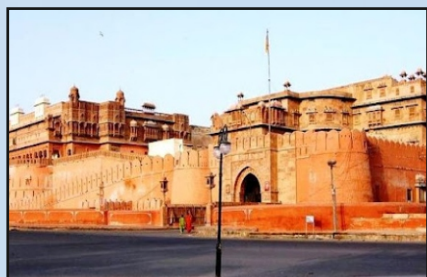
We are pleased to inform you that International Veterinary Pathology Congress 2021, encompassing XXXVIII Annual Conference of Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (IAVP), XII Annual Meeting of Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists (ICVP) and International Symposium on **“Advances in Veterinary Pathology for Diagnosis and Control of Emerging and Re-emerging Diseases of Livestock, Wild Animals and Poultry”** will be jointly organized by Department of Veterinary Pathology, College of Veterinary and Animal Science, RAJUVAS, Bikaner, Rajasthan in association with Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists and Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists from 17th to 19th December, 2021 through hybrid mode. The International Veterinary Pathology Congress 2021 will bring under one umbrella the Veterinary Pathologists, Disease diagnosticians, students and scientists from other fields of sciences to share research findings, ideas and intellectually explore the scope of Veterinary Pathology in the field of one health, food security and environmental protection.

About University

Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (RAJUVAS), Bikaner was established on 13th May 2010. The University is located in heritage and palatial buildings of erstwhile Ganga Avenue housing the College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner (Since 1954) and its precincts, spreading over 200 acres of land. The University has sophisticated equipments and well-equipped facilities for the execution of the major three organs of the University i.e., Teaching, Research, and Extension. The University covers entire Rajasthan state with 30 institutions including 5 Veterinary Colleges (in which 2 are just sanctioned), 9 Livestock Research Station (LRS) and 16 Pashu Vigyan Kendra (PVK). The University is also pursuing its effort to execute state specific research through state sponsored centers of advance research for benefits of livestock owners, students and researchers.

Venue

Bikaner, formerly the capital of the princely state of Bikaner, was founded by Rao Bika in 1486. Since then it has traversed a long way to become the fourth largest city in Rajasthan, studded with impregnable Forts, magnificent Places and Grand Havelis noted for their architectural grandeur. Bikaner attracts tourist from all over the world. It would thus be the most fitting venue for hosting the XXXVIII Annual Conference of Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists and International Symposium on **“Advances in Veterinary Pathology for Diagnosis and Control of Emerging and Re-emerging Diseases of Livestock, Wild Animals and Poultry”**.



Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (IAVP)

IAVP was founded in March, 1974 during a scientific get-together of Veterinary Pathologists at the Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar, UP, in the country, at the time in the eve of Green Revolution, emphasis was largely laid on the necessity of expanding agricultural education. Almost simultaneously the scientists in field of Veterinary and Animal Husbandry faced challenge on the front of increasing demands for livestock and poultry production. The assembly of the pathologists in the form of annual conventions and symposia on the current problems in Veterinary Science was first held at Veterinary College, Bengaluru in 1983 but became an annual features only after 1986.

Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists (ICVP)

ICVP was established in 2008 under the aegis of Indian Society for Certification of Veterinary Pathologists as an independent certification organizations for personal accreditation in India. It aims for the advancements for Veterinary Pathology and its sub-specializations including Clinical Pathology, Avian Pathology, Aquatic Animal Pathology, Toxicologic-Pathology, Laboratory Animal Pathology etc. by establishing standards of training and experience. The organization was pioneered, conceived and developed by a group of 22 life members of the Indian Associations of Veterinary Pathologists having recognizable stature in academia, research industry and practice, identified as Charter Members.
