Professor Hemant Dadhich (55), Director Research, RAJUVAS, Bikaner, Rajasthan is a renowned Veterinary Pathologist and University administrator. He was born on March 9, 1966 in Bikaner Rajasthan. He did BSc from the Rajasthan University, Jaipur in 1984 before joining the Rajasthan Agriculture University, Bikaner to obtain BVSc&AH degree in 1990. With keen interest in disease and diagnostics, Dr Dadhich did MVSc (1993) and PhD (1999) degrees in Veterinary Pathology from the RAU, Bikaner. He has been instrumental in teaching and conducting research in the Veterinary Pathology for over 25 years. He was selected Professor and Head, College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner in May 2011. He also served as Associate Professor and Head, CV&ASc, Bikaner (2005-2011) and Associate Professor, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Addis Ababa University, Ethiopia under UNDP (2005-2006). He was Officer in-Charge (2001-2005), Senior Assistant Professor (2000-2005), Assistant Professor (1996-2005) and Instructor (1994-1996) in Department of Veterinary Pathology, CV&ASc, Bikaner. Earlier he served as VAS in Department of Animal Husbandry, Rajasthan (1990-1994) and T-4 at National Research Centre on Camel, Bikaner, Rajasthan (1990). He has supervised 20 MVSc and 6 PhD students in discipline of Veterinary Pathology. During this time, he has published more than 120 research articles in national and international journals and authored many book chapters. Professor Dadhich has credit of completing several research Projects.

Prof. Hemant Dadhich has experience of about 11 years in administration at the RAJUVAS, Bikaner. During the period, he has been shaping the university through significant changes, growth and development. He has made several contributions at the University, which includes the development and implementation of university strategic programs while serving as the Registrar of the RAJUVAS. As the Dean Post-Graduate Studies, Dr Dadhich has promoted excellence in teaching and learning; research and engagement with several other institutions and has encouraged interdisciplinary research amongst teachers and students. As Director Research, he is continuing to offer his leadership in developing opportunities for faculty and staff and promoting more diverse and inclusive commitments in the development of animal husbandry sector. He is recipient of University Scholarship for Postgraduation; IAVP-Best Paper Award (1995), IAVP-Savitri Sinha Best Paper Presentation Award (1997), ISHEER Award (1999), Republic Day Appreciation Award (2002) and Certificate of Appreciation by RAJUVAS, Bikaner (2011) for organizing National Seminar. He is also associated with international organizations like-WAAVP, AVMA and life member of IAVP, SIIP etc.. Professor Dadhich is conferred with Fellowships of National Academy of Veterinary Sciences and Society for Immunology and Immuno-Pathology.

The Association confers Fellowship and the title of Fellow of Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (FIAVP) on Prof. Hemant Dadhich for his outstanding contributions to the advancement of Veterinary Pathology in India.
