CITATION FOR AWARD OF THE IAVP FELLOWSHIP, 2020

Dr Susen Kumar Panda (52), an eminent Veterinary Pathologist is Professor and Head, Department of Veterinary Pathology, Odisha University of Agriculture & Technology, Bhubaneswar. He is engaged in teaching and research in discipline of Veterinary Pathology and extension activities of the University, since last 26 years. He was born on 15th April, 1969 and obtained BVSc&AH, MVSc and PhD (Veterinary Pathology) degrees from OUA&T, Bhubaneshwar in 1989, 1992 and 2009, respectively. After serving Farm Supervisor under DAHDF, GOI Scheme (1992-93) and Junior Veterinary Officer, Govt. of Orrisa (1994-95) for a short span; he joined as Assistant Professor at Department of Veterinary Pathology, OUA&T, Bhubaneswar in 1995. He was promoted as Associate Professor in 2009 and Professor in 2012 and he is serving as Head of Department of Veterinary Pathology since 2006. During his professional career, Dr Panda has guided 32 MVSc and 7 PhD students. He has handled 6 research projects as PI and Co-PI. He has published 160 research articles in national and international journals of repute, 15 popular articles, 2 practical manuals, authored one book and 3 book chapters. He has attended more than 95 national and international seminars, conferences, training programs and workshops and delivered lead papers, oral and poster presentations. Dr Panda has research areas of interest on wildlife, farm animal and poultry diseases.

He organized IAVP-Veterinary Pathology Congress, 2013 at Bhubaneswar and conducted VCI sponsored CVE trainings on Diagnosis and Control of Bird Flu and Postmortem examination for State Government Veterinarians. Dr Panda has participated in several radio and TV interviews and his views are also highlighted in Odia and English newspapers about awareness on animal diseases. He has bagged several awards viz. IVA-Dr Ganti A. Sastry Award for the best article in Veterinary Pathology published in the Indian Veterinary Journal (1994), Shri Ram Lal Agrawal National Award for the advancement of indigenous veterinary medicine (1996 and 1997), OUA&T-Best Teacher Award (2008-09), IAVP-Best Wild Life Pathologist Award (2015), Diplomate, Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists (2016), IAVP-Dr B.C. Nayak Memorial Lecture Award (2017) etc. Dr Panda is serving as General Secretary of OUA&T Alumni Association, Treasurer, Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists and President of Indian Veterinary Association, Odisha. He has served as Executive Member and IAVP Zonal Secretary (East Zone).

The Association confers Fellowship and the title of Fellow of Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (FIAVP) on Dr S.K. Panda for his outstanding contributions to the advancement of Veterinary Pathology in India.
