It gives us immense pleasure to inform you that the Department of Veterinary Pathology, Veterinary College, Hebbal, Bengaluru along with IAVP, ASVP and ICVP is organizing an International Seminar on “Emerging horizons in diagnosis of animal and poultry diseases: towards sustainable production in Asian countries” along with Veterinary Pathology Congress in the month of November 2017. The Organizing Committee cordially invites all the Veterinary Pathologists in Asia, Veterinary and Biomedical Scientists, Academicians and Scholars to take part in this event.

The seminar will focus on the recent trends and technologies available for disease diagnosis in animals and poultry with emphasis on need based approaches. The deliberations of the event will bring to limelight the lacunae currently faced in combating emerging infectious diseases, their rapid diagnosis and control strategies. The main objective will be to bridge the gap between the available technology and its judicious adoption by academicians/industry and efficient use by practitioners.

ABOUT THE HOST & CITY

The Veterinary College, Bengaluru was inaugurated on 25th July, 1958 the college was initially affiliated to Mysore University, Mysore and at present is one of the constituent College of Karnataka Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries Sciences University, Bidar. The College is located in the centre of the city on the Kempegowda International Airport road (30 Kms from the

venue) and the city is well connected by railway facility. The railway stations (KSR Bengaluru and Cantonment) are at relatively shorter distance from the venue. The route map to reach the venue from Railway station and Airport is appended. The weather condition in Bangalore during November will be pleasant (15-20° C) but the delegates are advised to carry warm clothing.

CONGRESS VENUE

The venue of the Convention is Veterinary College, Hebbal, Bengaluru. Bengaluru city is among the top preferred entrepreneurial and educational locations in the world and well connected to different parts of the country by AIR, TRAIN and ROAD. The venue of the Convention is located about 30 kms from the KEMPEGOWDA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, Bengaluru and you can choose airport Volvo buses and alight at CBI bus stop or Ganganagar or you can hire private taxis and reach the venue from airport. If you choose to travel by train/bus, the venue is about 7 kms from Bengaluru Cant/City Railway station(SBC)/Central Bus stand and you can reach the venue by taxi/auto. ABOUT THE PARTICIPATING ORGANISATIONS

Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (<http://iavp.org>)

(IAVP) was founded in March, 1974 during a scientific get-together of Veterinary Pathologists at the Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar. In the country, at that time in the eve of green revolution, emphasis was largely laid on the necessity of expanding agricultural education. Almost simultaneously the scientist in the field of Veterinary and Animal husbandry faced challenge on the front of increasing demands for livestock and poultry production. The assembly of pathologists in the form of annual conventions and symposia on the current problems in Veterinary Science was first held at Veterinary College, Bengaluru in 1983 but became an annual feature only after 1986.

Asian Society of Veterinary Pathology (<http://asvp.info>)

(ASVP), founded in 2003, is a federation of organisations in Asian countries that are fostering the advancement of Veterinary Pathology in the region. It has eight member organisations representing the profession in Japan, South Korea, Vietnam, Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines and India. The ASVP general body meets once in two years. The society encourages scientific and professional co-operation among Veterinary Pathologists practicing the discipline in member countries and acts as a single voice of Veterinary Pathology in the region.

Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists (<http://icvp.in>)

(ICVP) was established in 2008 under the aegis of Indian Society for Certification of Veterinary Pathologists as an independent certification organization for personal accreditation in India. It aims for the advancement of Veterinary Pathology and its sub-specializations including Clinical Pathology, Avian Pathology, Aquatic Animal Pathology, Toxicologic Pathology, Laboratory Animal Pathology etc. by establishing standards of training and experience. The organization was pioneered, conceived & developed by a group of twenty-two life members of the Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists having recognizable stature in academia, research, industry and practice, identified as Charter Members.

Submission of Abstracts

Abstracts for Oral/Poster presentation not exceeding 250 words (System will not allow more than this limit) excluding title which you can input it online, authors and affiliation, must be filled for all authors - Author, Co Authors and Corresponding Authors.

Title of the Paper: Must be less than 250 characters. More than that system will not accept.

Authors Details: A complete detail of author as expected by the system is to be filled in online. Care must be taken to add additional author if you have co author as the system is capable of adding any number of authors and must select atleast one author and also must select the presentation author online.

Additional Details: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusions must be filled online. Sub-headings in the text should be avoided.

The Abstracts submitted will be evaluated by a Screening Committee and the corresponding author and all other authors will be intimated about the acceptance (Oral/Poster) well in advance. However, only registered delegates will be invited for oral/poster presentation.

Presentation:

Oral: All oral presentations should be made by power point presentation for less than 4-5 minutes for discussion. The speakers are advised to bring the presentation in pen drive/CD or upload online.

Poster: Poster shall be of less than 4 feet (height) and 3 feet (width). The presenters will be allotted code numbers (will be intimated) and the same shall be displayed on the poster board.
