The Organizing Committee cordially invites all Veterinary Pathologists, Academicians, Researchers and Scholars for their contributions in this mega event of knowledge sharing and dissemination.

The conference theme was selected with the idea that recently various new diseases were emerged in India in animals and humans like lumpy skin disease (LSD), African swine fever (ASF), and COVID-19. These emerging and transboundary infections are a serious global concern to the animal population. The well-structured scientific sessions in this Symposium cater these needs along with covering all important aspects of Veterinary Pathology.

About Venue: ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute

The ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute (ICAR-IVRI) under the aegis of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Government of India, is one of the oldest Institutions in the country. This Institute was established in 1889 as an Imperial Bacteriological Laboratory at Pune, Maharashtra and completed 133 glorious years by making many significant achievements and meeting the food security in the country through control and eradication of various diseases. The Institute was given Deemed University status by UGC in 1983. The Institute has two campuses (Mukteswar and Bengaluru) and three regional stations (Palampur, Kolkata and Pune). The main mandate of this ISO 9001:2008 certified Institute is to conduct the basic and strategic research to enhance the animal health and productivity and to improve the livelihood of farmers through technology dissemination. This Institute is playing a pioneer role as a torch bearer in the field of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, and providing higher education in all disciplines of Veterinary Sciences.

Presently, the Institute offers under graduation in Veterinary Science (BVSc & AH), MVSc in 19 and PhD in 17 disciplines of Veterinary Sciences, 22 Post Graduate Diploma courses, and 68 Certificate and Vocational courses. So far, the ICAR-IVRI has awarded 2385 National Diploma and 5423 degrees till X Convocation held on 23rd August, 2022. The Institute has 202 Scientists and 191 faculty members actively participating in the teaching and student guiding activities of the Deemed University. The Institute has well equipped facilities for teaching and training in the form of smart classrooms, virtual class room infrastructure and excellent R&D Laboratories. The Institute also has facilities-like CADRAD, Referral Veterinary Polyclinic, Centre for Wildlife, Livestock Farms, National Library of Veterinary Science, National Museum, Human Hospital, ATIC, ARIS Cell, Auditorium, and Experimental Animal Facilities.



How to reach Conference Venue, ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar

The venue of the Veterinary Pathology Congress-2023 is ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar-243 122, Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh. The ICAR-IVRI is located in Bareilly, UP. It is near to the foothills of the Kumaon range of mountains with several tourist spots including Nainital, Mathura, Agra, Ayodhya etc. Bareilly is well connected by air, rail and road. The ICAR-IVRI, Bareilly is equally distanced 250 km from the Delhi and Lucknow. The travelling time is 1 hr by flight and 5 - 6 hrs by road and train from Delhi and Lucknow. The ICAR-IVRI is located at a distance of 8 km from Bareilly Junction and Bareilly Airport, and 1 km from Izatnagar Railway station. The travelling time is 30 min. to reach the ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar by Auto from Bareilly Junction and Airport. The weather in Bareilly during December is usually cold with the average temperature of around 18 °C.

Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists

The Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists (IAVP) was founded in 1974 during a scientific get-together of Veterinary Pathologists held at the

ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar. Annual Convention and Symposia of the Pathologists was first held at Veterinary College, Bengaluru in 1983 and is being continued as an annual event since 1986. The Association aims to consolidate professional ethics and encourage brotherhood among the professionals for consequent attainment of excellence. IAVP has been organizing Annual Conventions and Symposia for inspiring the academic pursuits of Pathologists by arranging presentations of research papers and invited lectures from Pathologists and other Scientists of Eminence. The recommendations of the Annual Conventions and the Symposia are communicated to the ICAR and other Government bodies to help them chalk out development policies and programs at the National level.

Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists

The Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists (ICVP) was established in 2008 under the aegis of the Indian Society for Certification of Veterinary Pathologists as an independent certification organization for individual's professional accreditation in India. It aims for advancements in Veterinary Pathology and sub-specializations including clinical pathology, avian pathology, aquatic animal pathology, laboratory animal pathology, toxicopathology etc. by establishing standards of training and experience.
